

Dear Dr. Van Goethem,

We would like to follow up on the letter we had sent last week regarding the new restrictions. Health Certificates for hatching eggs and live poultry to the United States must now include the statements highlighted below. New model health certificates are available on the APHIS website.

The specific statements required are:

1. Hatching eggs / Poultry did not originate from France after October 1, 2023.
2. Hatching eggs / Poultry did not transit France prior to collection for shipment for export to the United States.
3. Hatching egg / Poultry shipment will not transit France after leaving the premises of origin.
