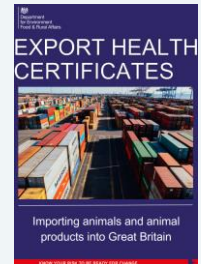



Notes

There is a locked formula in cell A5 of the 'search by code' worksheet. This cell also displays the search results.

Type the 10 digit commodity code in cell B2 and press enter. The risk category will appear in cell A5. You can only search for one commodity at a time.
