On the international agreement and other regulatory legal acts in the field of application of sanitary measures in the Customs Union

The Interstate Council of the Eurasian Economic Community (the supreme body of the customs union) at the level of Heads of Governments has decided to:

1. Accept the customs union agreement on sanitary measures (**attached**).

2. Carry out, by April 1, 2010, domestic procedures necessary for entry into force of the international agreement referred to in paragraph 1 of this Decision.

3. Governments of States - members of the Customs Union within the Eurasian Economic Community, together with the Commission of the Customs Union, by April 1, 2010, to prepare and agree on drafts of:

- Uniform list of goods subject to sanitary and epidemiological supervision (control) at the customs border and in the customs territory of the Customs Union;

- Uniform forms of documents confirming safety of products (goods);

- Regulations on the procedure for the state sanitary and epidemiological supervision (control) of persons and vehicles crossing the customs border of the Customs Union, of controlled goods moved across the customs border of the Customs Union and the customs territory of the Customs Union;

- the Uniform sanitary and epidemiological and hygienic requirements for products subject to sanitary and epidemiological supervision (control).

Ensure the entry into force of these documents from July 1, 2010.

To make a provision in these documents for procedures eliminating the reissue by the authorized bodies of the Parties of documents issued by one of the Parties and confirming safety of products (goods), as well as carrying out for this purpose of repeated laboratory studies (tests).

Parties to ensure the formalization of the said rules in the agreements by April 1, 2010.

4. The Commission of the Customs Union to prepare and submit to the scheduled meeting of the EurAsEC Interstate Council (the supreme body of the Customs Union) at the level of Heads of Governments a draft decision of transfer to the Commission of authorities stipulated by the international agreement referred to in paragraph 1 of this Decision.

5. Governments of states - members of the Customs Union within the Eurasian Economic Community to take measures to prepare changes in national laws in order to bring them, from July 1, 2010, into compliance with the international agreement referred to in paragraph 1 of this Decision.
